Loaves and Fishes: Hello All,

This has been a very different time for Loaves & Damp; Fishes. The CAB and Hospice were closed and they were our donation points for food in Wellsford. Also all churches were shut and they supported us with food donations.

I registered Loaves & Development and Auckland Council. In doing this we were given options as to how we could be assisted by these organisations during the shutdown.

From a small anonymous foodbank with a large area to cover we are now a well-known foodbank with a smaller area. Kaiwaka and

Mangawhai have systems in place to help with food shortages in those areas. As time goes on we will continue to support these places when needed.

When level 4 came into being we dealt with 13 organisations now we have 26 organisations. Our contact had been through the CAB each weekday. While the CAB was shut the contact was made through me and we setup a contactless delivery at the

church. This should change as we continue in level 1.

Another source of food collection is from Food Rescue in Warkworth. As most of the workers and our workers were over the age of 70 the government had restrictions about the movement of these people. The Mahurangi Community Foodbank took over the collection and supply of food. We were contacted and this group brought food up as we needed it.

Special thanks must go to Deborah from Te Ha Oranga and Tania Hamilton from Wellsford Plunket with the amount of help and support given to me.

I wish to thank Michelle, Roger and Davina from Mahurangi Foodbank, Heather and Mark for doing all the shopping required, Jo from Budgeting, Kirk from Wharehine Contractors, Maretta the Public Health Nurse, and the support of Louise, Susan and Mary for the many phone calls answered. Thank you Max and Eileen for donating fruit, we made up 42 fruit parcels and distributed in the community. Kiwi Harvest deliver to us at present each week which is keeping the foodbank stocked along with community donations. Thank you the ones who thought to make a donation to us of money. We appreciate your generosity. Our donation for food boxes are now held at CAB, Hospice, Wharehine Contractors and Wrightsons.

Now some Numbers, Level 4, 29 parcels, Level 3, 10 parcels, Level 2, 23 parcels, Since Level 2 we have distributed to families 123 fruit and vegetable packs. March 20: 18 parcels, April 20: 27parcels, May 20: 33 parcels, June 20: 17 parcels (up to 12 June)

Welcome to our new and valued helpers, Sue, Pam, Heather, also appreciated are Desiree and Maddie, you all make Tuesdays that much more enjoyable. Thank you Willis and Robyn for all the calls you took from me. Karen you were a great release valve when needed, you all made my stress levels a lot less. I'm so thankful for the team that helped us through Covid 19.
