Stuart's songs include: "In Christ Alone" (2002, co-written with Keith Getty), "Beautiful Saviour" and "The King Of Love." Townend, son of a Church of England vicar in Halifax, West Yorkshire, was the youngest of four children. He studied literature at the University of Sussex. Townend started learning to play the piano at age seven. At the age of thirteen, he made a Christian commitment and began songwriting at age twenty-two.
