So often, Lord, we take your gifts for granted; so often we are blind; so often we are brutal; so often we try to prove our superiority or make a profit out of your creatures.


In their silence and suffering, you rebuke us, and sometimes by riding

PASTOR'S BLURB FOR SEPTEMBER 2022

Quote: 'The Cannibals! You will be eaten by the Cannibals!' These words were spoken to dissuade John Paton from witnessing the gospel in the New Hebrides Islands. For most Christians, the violent barbarism of the islanders was sufficient reason not to live among them as missionaries. These were islands that were supposed to belong to Satan forever and where his power was too deeply entrenched to be safely challenged. But Paton could not neglect 'the awful challenge of the unsaved,' and prayed that he 'might be the means of bringing the perishing to the Saviour.' When Paton arrived on the island of Tanna in 1858, he discovered the dangers first-hand. 'The depths of Satan.... were uncovered there before our eyes in the daily lives of the people.' he wrote. Paton's plan was to live among people, earn their trust, learn their language, and bear testimony to the cleansing blood of Christ.

On many occasions when his life was threatened by musket-wielding natives, Paton relied on prayer. A biographer writes: 'He trusted only in the Lord who had placed him there and to whom had been given all power in heaven and earth... He prayed to Christ "either protect me or take me home to His glory" Soon Paton was able to speak to them of 'sin and salvation', and he did this unceasingly.'

During twenty-five years on the islands of Tanna and Aniwa, Paton was used by God to convert most of the people and establish strong churches. Once he was back in Scotland for fund-raising, he wrote that 'my soul longed after the holy Sabbaths of Aniwa.' How could any one person succeed against such overwhelming odds and during such satanic danger? An answer is given in Revelation 12:11 which says that Christians such as Paton "have conquered him (Satan) by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death". End quote.

The above quote was taken from a commentary on Revelation by Richard Phillips. I don't know about you, but in my humble opinion, this western society (I see that New Zealand is just the same as Australia, Europe, and America/Canada) is becoming increasingly satanic in its opposition to Christianity. Therefore, we do not have the choice that Paton had, of whether to go to the New Hebrides Islands or not. The satanic world is coming to us. As your brother in the Kingdom of God and patient endurance, the best thing I can do to help all of us is to leave you with the word of life in Revelation 12:11: 'They (you) have conquered him (Satan) by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they (you) did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death.'

The Story behind the Hymns

Stand Up, Stand Up for Jesus

In Philadelphia, during the great revival of 1858, over 5000 gathered to hear Rev. Dudley Tyng preach. As people gathered for this noonday prayer meeting, he used this opportunity to plead earnestly for each to "go now, ye that are men, and serve the Lord." It is said that over a thousand expressed a desire to become a Christian before the end of that meeting.

Just a few days later he left his study for a moment and went out to the barn to check on a mule he had harnessed to a machine that was shelling corn. When he patted the mule on his head, his sleeve caught in the cogs of the wheel and his arm was frightfully torn. His injury led to complications and a painful illness which resulted in his death. As he was dying, his father asked him if he had any message for his fellow ministers in the revival. He replied, "Let us all stand up for Jesus."

It was these words that inspired Dr George Duffield, Jr. to preach a memorial service for his late friend. He chose as his text Ephesians 6:14 "Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness." As a climax to the thought of the sermon he shared a hymn that he had written based on Tyng's dying words.

The phrase "Ye that are men now serve Him," continues to live on today through the text of the popular hymn "Stand Up Stand Up for Jesus." Let these words echo as our battle cry against those that may oppose the cause of Christ.
