

believe there are about 80 Newsletters delivered, I know I have not met you all, however you will have met me, mostly through these editorials I have the privilege of putting into the Newsletter. You will have gathered by now I am not particularly orthodox and certainly not conservative I am something other than fundamental. Yet I express faith in ways that are conversant and faithful to scripture, there are many people and churches over centuries for whom faith is expressed in this way. So when I ask, 'what is the kingdom (kin-dom)?' & 'How will people recognize it?' I go to the scriptures.
